

Coronavirus Contingency Plans and Options Elementary Programs

A	Regular On-Site School	Full Regular Program	595 per month as usual
B	Delayed On-Site School	Option 1, Decision is made in August to delay start of school to October, shorten December or other break, and extend school year.	All Grades 595 per month All payments made at the same time, but accounted to cover October to July 1 or so.
C	Digital-Concurrent with On-Site Classes due to family health circumstance	Attend all classes virtually in the mornings, students at home have afternoons flexible and finish work according to family schedule, with family help.	Grades 1-8 595 per month
D	Remote School Due to Coronavirus State Shut Down/Order/or School Decision Primary (ages 3-6) class to continue in session.	All major classes take place in the morning for 45 minutes each with 15 minute breaks. Each child has two 15 minute individual sessions per week, with a teacher or assistant, in the afternoons.	Grades 7&8 535 per month (10% off) Grades 1-6 445 per month (25% off) More reduced cost for parents due to the need to monitor and help younger children, the loss of childcare supervision needed at this age.
E	Alternating Hybrid School Model	School starts on site and then stops/starts	Grades 7&8 For each day of unexpected/previously unscheduled remote learning, there will be a per diem off set of \$6 per day (10% off) Grades 1-6 For each day of unexpected/previously unscheduled remote learning, there will be a per diem offset of 8.50 per day (25% off) These discounts will be applied to your next bill. If you have paid ahead on a regular monthly payment plan, we will credit toward future year, club, aftercare Please note that since year long prepayments are already discounted, we cannot provide refunds.
